AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

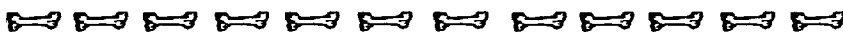

***NR1.08100.37100.* Veteran Classes - FOR PEKINGESE - SAT.** Class for dogs & class for bitches 10 years & over.

***NR1.08400.* Gun Dog Classes - FOR POINTERS - SAT.** - Class for dogs & class for bitches who have earned at least the title of Junior Hunter (JH) or a Placement at a Derby Stakes.

***NR1.08200.* Hunting Classes - FOR VIZSLAS - SAT.** - Class for dogs & class for bitches who have completed requirements for the AKC Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Title.

***NR1.08800.* Working Dog Classes - FOR PORTUGUESE WATER DOGS - SAT.** - Class for dogs and class for bitches that have earned a Portuguese Water Dog Club of America Apprentice Water Dog Title or above. Proof of certification must accompany entry. A Junior Water Dog Title does not count towards this class.

***NR1.08800.* Working Dog Classes - FOR CAIRN TERRIERS - SAT.** - Class for intact dogs and class for intact bitches that have earned an AKC Junior (JE), Senior (SE) or Master (ME) Earth Dog Title.

00900. BEST OF BREED (00100. VARIETY) COMPETITION

**SPECIAL ATTRACTION CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES
FOR VIZSLAS, GREATER SWISS MOUNTAIN DOGS & CAIRN TERRIERS - SATURDAY**

The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch themselves may be altered, but not their get or produce.

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dog and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Stud Dog only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - Same as the Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male maybe entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

FOR CAIRN TERRIERS - SATURDAY

- Overnight R.V. parking with **no reservation is \$60.00 cash each day** per vehicle, space available.

- No cones or markers in the parking area.

The Greenwich Kennel Club, Inc. their members, governors, officers, agents and/or superintendents will not be liable for any damage, loss or injury which may be sustained while on the show grounds. This is to include the disappearance, loss, theft, injury and/or death of dogs entered in these events.

Crate/Grooming Tent - The clubs will provide a special Crate/Grooming Tent for the use of all exhibitors bringing their dogs in crates or carrying cases. The tent is arranged in aisles and work spaces, permitting quick access to rings. The Committee asks the cooperation of all exhibitors in accepting assignments and arranging work tables. Crates and tables will not be allowed in the aisles. Grooming tables in excess of 24 x 36 inches will not be permitted. Most Toy Breeds will be assigned a corner ring. **CRATES CANNOT BLOCK EXITS OF TENT PER FIRE MARSHAL.** Exhibitors **MUST** be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities, building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
