Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Take Exit #3 (Rte. 7) South for about 17 miles. In Norwalk Rte. 7 becomes "Main Ave." Turn right at light just past Starbucks (on right). At 2nd set of lights, go left onto "Rte. 7 Connector" to I-95 North to next Exit #16. See Above.
